Welcome to the Naval Amphibious Base Little Creek

### Environmental Restoration Program

NAB Little Creek, located in Virginia Beach, Virginia, provides logistic facilities and support services for local commands, organizations, home-ported ships, and other units to meet the amphibious warfare training requirements of the Armed Forces of the United States. The base is in the northwest corner of Virginia Beach and its western border abuts the city of Norfolk, Virginia. The area surrounding this 2,215-acre base is low lying and relatively flat with several fresh water lakes (Chubb Lake, Lake Bradford, Little Creek Reservoir/ Lake Smith, and Lake Whitehurst) and four saltwater bodies (Little Creek Harbor, Little Creek Cove, Desert Cove, and Little Creek Channel that connects the coves and harbor with the Chesapeake Bay) located on or adjacent to the base.

NAB Little Creek was commissioned on July 30, 1945, by combining four contiguous activities. The Navy began purchasing land in the area from private estates and the Pennsylvania Railroad just prior to World War II. The first activity to be commissioned was the Amphibious Training Base in the southwestern corner of the present base near Little Creek Harbor. The base's mission was the training of landing craft personnel for operational assignments. Over the last 50 years, NAB Little Creek has expanded in both area and the complexity of its mission.

The documents prepared for the program are maintained in information repositories for review by the public. The Administrative Record is maintained at the Naval Facilities Engineering Command, 6506 Hampton Boulevard Norfolk, Virginia 23508-1278.

NAB Little Creek has developed a Community Relations Plan and established a Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) comprised of members of the community, local environment group members, and state and federal officials, who meet annually to keep the community informed on environmental issues at NAB Little Creek.

NAB Little Creek has conducted a proactive community relations program throughout the Environmental Restoration and CERCLA process. A Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) is an advisory board made up of community members, local environmental group members, and local state and federal officials. The RAB at NAB Little Creek was initially formed in 1994 and has been an integral part of the community relations program since its inception. Currently, there are 10 members of the RAB and the board meets annually to allow concerned citizens to communicate and interact with the Navy on ER activities. At each meeting members are given updates, briefings and/or technical presentations on the status of the ER sites with ongoing work. Public meetings and RAB meetings are held at NAB Little Creek or at an agreed upon offsite location. The date, time, and location of public meetings will be published in the Virginian Pilot.
